- Books need to be returned two weeks after issue or before
- Lost books will be paid for by parents.

In order to sign up to be a library member, you will need to provide a current Proof of Address (can be a bill, bank statement etc).

If you would like to become a library member, please fill in the information at the bottom of this form and hand it in to the office. Once the office has all the required information, the membership can be processed, and you will be notified within one week that your card is ready to collect.
